# Information about the COVID-19 Vaccination (As of Dec. 23)



- ■Type of Vaccine used: The bivalent vaccine targeting the original coronavirus strain and the omicron subvariant made by Pfizer and Moderna
- \*Currently, the above vaccine can be given only one time.
- ■Eligibility: Anyone who fulfills all of the following conditions.
- ► People aged 12 and older
- ▶ People who have already had the 1st and 2nd shots
- ▶ People for whom three months have passed since their previous vaccination
- ▶ People who have not received either of the following vaccine shots (3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> )
  - The Omicron bivalent vaccine made by Pfizer or Moderna (BA.1, BA.4-5)
  - \*The Novavax initial vaccine after Nov. 8, 2022

#### ■The period to send out the vaccination coupon:

Vaccination coupons for the omicron booster shots are mailed to those eligible around ten days before 3 months have passed since their previous shot. People who received vaccination coupons for the 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> booster shot, but did not use them, can use these coupons for the omicron booster shot.

\* If you have received COVID-19 vaccines overseas, or if you don't receive your booster coupon even after your vaccination period has passed, please apply by reading the QR code on the right or contact Ashiya City COVID-19 Vaccine Call Center.

#### Prepare for a Possible Double Outbreak of COVID-19/Influenza

A surge in the number of COVID-19 cases and a flue outbreak striking at the same time could place extra pressure on the medical system.

  When your COVID-19 test is positive, you can start recuperation at home after voluntary health care registration.
- For those at high risk of severe illness:
- If you have a family doctor, first call the doctor and seek consultation.
- \*If you don't have a family doctor, contact a fever outpatient clinic (medical or testing medical institutions) and see the doctor.

## New Year Special Interview - Horie Kenichi (Abridged)

Last June, Mr. Horie Kenichi succeeded in crossing the Pacific Ocean alone on his yacht without stopping at any ports. It has been 60 years since he became the youngest person to cross the Pacific Ocean on his yacht. He is now 83 years old, the oldest person in the world who succeeded in this great achievement. We asked him about his adventure and new challenge.

Born in Osaka City. Lives in Ashiya

#### ⟨Departure during the spread of Coronavirus infection⟩

60 years ago, I had no idea that I would be the oldest person to take on the challenge I did in 2022. During the many years of sailing experiences, I hoped that I could sail until 100 years old. However, I decided not to wait until I reached 100. Last year's sailing was initially scheduled in 2021, but I had to postpone to 2022 due to the spread of corona infections. Fortunately, this was timely as it was the 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary of my first solo crossing of the Pacific Ocean. The yacht used this time was designed in Yokohama and build in Hiroshima, but I did not have enough time to meet everyone concerned as I was so nervous about Corona. Although I sailed alone, I had to submit negative proof of infection 72 hours before the departure from San Francisco

#### <Focus my attention on sailing >

During the voyage, I got up when the sun rose and went to bed when the sun set. Yachts usually travel at a speed of 7 or 8 km per hour. Even when I was sleeping, the sound of wave and the rocking of the hull told me if the yacht was going smoothly. Even when I was unconscious, I was concentrating all the time. It took lot of nervous energy. I had to be careful not to miss my daily satellite phone calls because the ringtone was sometimes lost in the sound of the waves. I examined my sailing and visualized my next sailing. I still enjoy sailing. The past 2 years have been very exciting, both planning the voyage and building the yacht.

#### It's good when advancing at an average speed>

On my solo voyage 60 years ago, I took the north route, but this time I chose the south route. This route goes through the trade wind zone as trade wind is stable easterly wind that is ideal and best for yachts. Thanks to the good wind, I made good progress. There are, of course, days of bad weather and setbacks. Now we have a satellite tracking system that shows my current location hourly on the map, which can be viewed on the website and some

of my web visitors let my wife know that my yacht was not advancing. So the visitor was sailing with me. A yacht advances about 200 km per day, so even if it retreats for one hour, it is still advancing averagely in 24 hours.

#### <The key is to merge with nature>

I started sailing 68 years ago when I entered Kansai University Dai-ichi Senior High School and joined the sailing club. The encounter was fortunate for me. It was only nine years after the war ended, so few people were sailing at that time.

The main difference between sailing and other sports is the power source. During the junior high school days, I did gymnastics. The source of power is your body, while the wind is the source of power for a yacht. It is important to make good use of the wind's power. You only use your energy to steer the yacht. This is probably the reason why people of all ages can enjoy sailing. However, it is not as easy as we think, because we are dealing with nature. We never know where the wind will come from. It is important not to confront nature but to integrate yourself into nature.

#### <The strongest time in my life>

I can get anxious during the voyage. What if the wind get stronger while I am sleeping. If you start thinking negatively, you will get caught up in more and more bad thoughts. I am most afraid of my imagination. I think it takes a lot of experiences to overcome fear. In that sense, the present is the strongest time for me. Just thinking about it does not make you stronger. It is important to repeat the experiences,

to take the first step and try.

Some people may find it difficult to try something. But everyone has tried something in some form or another. For me, as a clumsy person, it happened to be sailing. Challenges start with one's imagination. I encourage you, young people, to imagine. I am now catching the wind, looking out the sea and unfolding the map of the world in my mind.

#### <From Ashiya to the infinite world ocean>

When I was a member of the sailing club in high school, we practiced off the coast of Ashiya. I remember sailing towards the incinerator which is no longer there. In May 1980, I moved to Ashiyahama Seaside Town. I lived on the 29th floor, and I was happy to see the light of Tomogashima Lighthouse from there. Every time I saw the light, I felt I was back in my youth. I was relieved when I could see the Rokko mountain range beyond the Kii Channel. Originally, the light of that lighthouse reaches 38 km, but from 85 m above the ground, it can reach Ashiya, which is more than 50 km away. Ashiya has both mountains and the sea, and the sea is connected to the world.

As long as my body lasts, I want to keep challenging myself until I am 100 years old. I am envisioning my next challenge.

# Cost of Living Relief for Families with Children

(子育て世帯物価高騰対策給付金 kosodate-setai bukka koto taisaku kyufu-kin)

To support families with children, Ashiya City will provide 30,000 yen for each child eligible for Child Allowance (児童手当 jido teate).

- ♦ Eligibility: Those who have a Certificate of Residence (住民票 juminhyo) in Ashiya City as of August 31, 2022, and meet any of the conditions below.
  - ➤ Those receiving Child Allowance, including Special Benefits (特例給付 tokurei kyufu) for September 2022
  - ➤ Those receiving Child Allowance, including Special Benefits, for newborns who were born between September 1, 2022, and February 28, 2023, and who have a Certificate of Residence in the city at the time of the newborn's birth
- **♦ Payment Amount**: 30,000 yen per eligible child
- ♦ Application: Necessary documents must be submitted, postmarked by Tues., February 28, 2023, to the Child-rearing Promotion Section, ₹659-8501 (no address necessary). Documents needed were sent out on December 9, 2022. They may also be downloaded from the Ashiya City website. Public servants need to apply.

# Special Benefit to Support Families with Children

Eligible recipients who are yet to receive the benefit should apply for the Special Benefit to Support Families with Children (子育て世帯生活支援特別給付金 kosodate setai seikatsu shien tokubetsu kyufu-kin).

- ♦ Eligible Children: Children born between April 2, 2004 (2002 if they have certain special needs) and February 28, 2023.

# Subsidy to Promote Energy-Efficient Household Appliance Purchases

(省工木家電製品購入推進事業補助金 sho-ene kaden seihin konyu suishin jigyo hojokin)


- ♦ Eligibility: Those who purchase eligible new and unused home appliances, totaling 50,000 yen before tax or more, from stores in Hyogo Prefecture between December 15, 2022, and March 31, 2023, and meet all of the criteria below.
  - ➤ Individuals who have an address in Ashiya City, or corporations (i.e. offices and businesses) located in the city
  - > Those who are not in arrears with their city taxes
  - ➤ Those who have not applied for Ashiya City's Subsidy to Promote Net Zero Energy Houses (ZEH) this fiscal year.
- ♦ Eligible Appliances with Uniform Energy Efficiency Labels
  - > Air conditioners with four stars or more
  - > Televisions with four stars or more
  - > Lighting fixtures with four stars or more
  - > Refrigerators and freezers with three stars or more
  - X Only once per household or corporation. Internet purchases are not eligible.
- ♦ Subsidy Amount: 20,000 yen for purchases totaling 100,000 yen or more before tax, or 10,000 yen for purchases totaling 50,000 yen or more before tax.
- ♦ Application: Make an electronic application or submit designated documents by mail between January 10 and March 31, 2023. Applications will be closed, however, when the budget limit is reached. Visit the Ashiya City website for details


# 1.17 Ashiya Pheonix Fund Subsidy

# Free Rental of Automatic Call Recorders

Free rental of "Automatic Call Recorder" is available, which prevents criminality with warning message and recording function to stop malicious telemarketing and special fraudulent phone calls. No construction work is required. It can be used by connecting to the landline phone at your home.



In this issue, we introduce Yamazaki Takao's "Ashiyagawa River" (Please refer to the Bulletin Ashiya, January issue.) This work depicts a view looking north from near Hanshin Ashiya Station. The green pointed-roofed building on the right is the Catholic Church built in 1956.

It was designed by architect, Hasebe Eikichi and its beautiful shape can be seen today. The Narihira Bridge can be seen at the back of the picture,

and the Ashiya Citizen's Center is depicted just northeast of the bridge. Yamazaki painted this picture in 1988, more than 20 years after he had already left Ashiya.

This picture also evokes his nostalgic memories of the time he spent with his master, Koide Narashige, and also memories of his own life. Today the scenery of Ashiyagawa River remains the same.

Koide Narashige's Atelier

Going to the west from Kimmitsu Bridge in the foreground, there was Koide Narashige's Residence, where Yamazaki also lived.

After Koide passed away in 1931, Yamazaki moved there in 1937, where he continued to work in his master's studio until 1962. This Koide Atelier, designed by an architect, Sasagawa Shinichi, started to construct in May 1927, had a floor area about 38 m² with a mezzanine floor. This atelier has been restored in the front yard of the Ashiya Museum of Art and History with Yamazaki's cooperation.

Yamazaki Takao (1905–1991) was born in Osaka. After graduating from Kobe Higher Commercial School (now Kobe University), he worked for Sanwa Bank from 1930. Wanting to learn directly from Koide, he attended the art school in Koide's studio. While he continued painting, he established an advertising company, Sun–AD Company Limited in 1964 and became its president. In 1962, he moved to Kanagawa Prefecture, where he produced many works on Mt. Fuji.

# Beekeeper Registration of Honeybees

Those who keep honeybees, including hobby beekeepers, are required to file a beekeeper registration with Hyogo Prefecture every year in January. However, those who fall under any of the conditions below do not need to register.



- > Temporarily keep only enough colonies for a short period of time, from a few weeks to a few months, for the purpose of pollination.
- > Keep bees in a structurally sealed facility for academic research purposes, etc.
- ➤ Only harvest honey, etc. from wild beehives of Japanese honeybees and do not set up hive boxes, log hives, etc. to keep them.







# Q & A on Promotion of "Reduction" and "Recycling" of Waste

Q: How much plastic waste is there?

A: It is about 15% of household waste (by weight)

Plastic waste is roughly classified into two kinds. Investigation showed the rate of plastic in each kind:

- ► Waste of Plastic Containers and Packaging (13 %): Candy bag, Pastry bag, Wrap (cellophane), etc.
- ► Waste of Plastic Products (2 %): Hanger, Spoon, etc.

We are promoting a plan to reconstruct the Refuse Disposal Center on the basis of this 15 % shown in the investigation.
