Towards a Multicultural City

Are there any foreign residents living around you?

Some of the foreigners were born and raised in Japan, while others are foreign students just arrived a week ago. The multilingual service Counter aims to be an advice counter where anyone can speak in their own language and there are no language barrier.

The Number of Foreign Residents is 1,892 (Excerpts)

Consultation is available in 6 languages.

Currently, (as of August 1, 2023), there are 1,892 foreign residents in Ashiya City. The number was about 1,600 in 2022, so the number has increased by about 300 in the past year. The number of nationalities is 64 and the languages used and contents of consultations are becoming more diverse.

In order to accommodate consultations from more people, we have started a multi-lingual consultation service. Please feel free to use this services at any time, if you have some trouble, don't understand something, or have difficulty understanding Japanese. If you have some foreigners near you who are in trouble, please let them know about the consultation service at the City Hall. We will continue to promote the creation of a multilingual city where everyone can enjoy their time together.



Ashiya School Lunch Recipes

■ Lemon Chicken

- Ingredients (Serves 4)
 8 x 40 g chicken (breasts)
 1 Tbsp shio-koji salted rice malt
 30 g katakuriko potato starch cooking oil as needed
 2 Tbsp lemon juice
- Seasonings2 Tbsp sugar
 - 1 Tbsp koikuchi darkcolored soy sauce
 - 2 tsp vinegar



☐ Directions:

- 1. Cut chicken into pieces and coat with salted *koji* (rice malt). Place in the refrigerator for about 30 minutes.
- 2. Dust the chicken with potato starch.
- Heat a generous amount of oil in a pan and cook chicken. When the chicken is browned, flip it over, reduce heat, and cover the pan with a lid. Cook until the chicken is fully done.
- 4. Remove chicken from the pan and wipe off any remaining oil in the pan.
- 5. Make sauce in the same pan. Add seasonings and bring them to a boil and then add lemon juice.
- 6. Return the chicken to the pan and coat it with the sauce.



Information about the COVID-19 Vaccination

Fall 2023 Start Vaccination (Vaccine for Omicron strain, XBB1.5)

The start of the Fall 2023 vaccination is scheduled to begin on Wed., Sept. 20 and is available for people who were ineligible for the Spring 2023 vaccination.

- *We plan to implement the vaccination program as follows, but it may change due to change in the government policy.
- Target persons: Persons aged 6 months or over who have completed the initial vaccinations and three months have passed since their previous vaccination
- * The vaccination starting fall 2023 is not obligatory, however, it is strongly advised for the elderly aged 65 and over, or those with underlying medical conditions or whose doctors decide they are high risk of developing severe symptoms. Please consider the effects and side effects of the vaccination before you decide whether or not to have the vaccination.
- Type of vaccine used: Monovalent vaccine for Omicron strain, XBB1.5

 Anyone over 6 years of age: Pfizer and Moderna vaccine

 Anyone under 5 years of age: Pfizer vaccine
- XThe formulation used differs depending on the age of target persons.
- ■Vaccination period: Sept. 20-the end of March, 2024
 - ▶For children aged 5-11: From Mon., Sept. 25
 - ▶For children under 4: From Mon., Oct.2
- ■Vaccination coupon: The vaccination coupon will be mailed to those eligible approx. ten days before three months have passed since their previous shot. If you have already received a coupon and did not use it, please use the coupon for the vaccination.
- ■How to make an appointment: Make an appointment at individual medical institutions .
- *Appointment method may vary depending on each medical institution.
- **Please confirm medical institutions from the city's website using the 2D code or *Koho Ashiya*, August issue. .
- *Any changes in medical institutions will be updated on the city website as needed. Please confirm the latest information from the city's website.
- ■Initial vaccinations are administered at the following medical institutions.
 - ▶For persons aged 12 or older: St. Maria hospital
 - ▶For children under 11 years of age: Medical institutions where children under 11 years of age can get vaccinated
- Please confirm medical institutions where children aged 11 or under can receive the vaccination from the city's website or Koho Ashiya, August issue.
